

For fundraising on the club level, I highly encourage everyone to check out the Youth Opportunities Fund which is due on **October 15th**! I'll leave a link to Key Club International's Website so that you can see the complete information.

Here's a short summary: the YOF is a grant for club funding, between \$250 and \$2,000, meant to assist your club in helping your local community through service. Before you plan to apply for a grant, create a budget assessment with your club. Then, create a Foundant account and fill out the online application, completing all steps.

If you miss the first application cycle deadline on October 15th, don't worry! There's a second application cycle next spring with its deadline on March 1st.
