Dream Inspiration Academy

At the 8/14 meeting, Max and Theresa Bryant of the Lakewood Club presented an overview of their Club's overseas project supporting the Dream Inspiration Academy organization in their mission of giving Nairobi slum children (about half the city's population) a shot at getting out of the generational poverty cycle through a quality elementary education. (https://inspirationacademykenya.org/) Kenya public education is rife with inadequate facilities, overcrowded and poorly trained teachers. If available in slums, classroom size is often 100 students with 5 to a desk.

Max and Theresa have been working with Dream Inspiration for 12 years, including multiple trips to Kenya to help out on the ground. This has culminated in coordinating donations from key individuals, churches, 6 Kiwanis clubs and other organizations to raise \$600K to fund the construction of a modern K-6 school in the Math are slum of Nairobi. The school will open 1/6/25 for the 2025 school year providing classrooms, labs, disability access, sanitary water and facilities, minor medical care, and 2 nutritious meals for 425 students in classes no larger than 30 kids.

They also coordinated with Jeffco Library to provide books and Project Cure to provide medical supplies and are now fundraising for furniture and operations sponsorships for students and teachers

(https://inspirationacademykenya.org/donations-grid/). The uniformed boys and girls will learn reading, writing, math, social studies, science, music and sports in both English and Swahili. For the students to be accepted for the school, their parents must be committed to supporting the education and have to nominally contribute either monetarily or physically to the school operations recognizing that providing free services doesn't work to elevate out of poverty.

The organization has proven that this level of education can get the students, one child at a time, out of the slum life and into the mainstream Nairobi community. If anyone is interested in joining Max and Theresa in a weeklong journey to Kenya for 3 days assisting the school opening and a 3-day safari trip, contact them, and please consider a donation or sponsorship.

What Is ProjectCURE?

Our group of volunteers (we have had between 6 and 14 each visit) has been visiting the ProjectCURE warehouse in Centennial on the last Monday of every month since January 2023. We spend up to 2-1/2 hours there. Our tasks are varied, but we have usually been assigned to open donated older Surgical Packs to select out useful items, discarding the items no longer suitable for use. We never know what our tasks will be each visit until we get there.

The ProjectCURE organization has similar warehouses in several cities around the USA collecting this type of Medical and Surgical Supplies and Equipment no longer suitable for use, from agencies wishing to dispose of it (from hospitals, medical offices and clinics). After extensive processing (such as the tasks we perform), the usable materials are packed and shipped all over the world to countries in need of such medical materials. Last year, over 30 countries received shipments from ProjectCURE where the materials were desperately needed and were in short supply.

Our next scheduled ProjectCURE event is set for Monday, August 26 at 9:30am and a signup sheet is available at meetings and online. For those desiring a ride to Centennial, we carpool from the 4Gs parking lot at 9:00am that morning.

- Total presales dollars \$1,000. Not a bad start, but still a ways to go!


Please reach out to your close contacts to try and generate some interest and hopefully sell some tickets or an ad on the placemat. Presales efforts this week include:
