## **EVENTS/ITEMS THAT NEED YOUR ATTENTION**

#### **PROPOSED BY-LAWS CHANGES**

#### **ARTICLE 4. OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS**

- 4.1. The officers will be a President, immediate past President, president, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary. The officers may also include one or more vice-president(s) a Co-Treasurer, if so defined in club policy.
  - 4.2. Officers' duties are as defined below and as may be additionally provided in club policy:

The president elect, immediate Past President, and Vice President (if any), have duties as usually pertain to the office or as may be assigned by the President or Board.

#### **ARTICLE 5. ELECTIONS AND VACANCIES**

- 5.3. The president, immediate past president, president-elect, vice-president treasurer, secretary, and vice president(s), (if any) will serve one-year or two-year terms as provided in club policy, beginning October 1 of each year. Directors may serve up to three-year terms, as provided in club policy, with each term beginning October 1 after election.
- 5.4. Vacancies will be filled as follows: President: by the president-elect, Vice-President, immediate past president, or vice president (if any), as provided in club policy.

#### **ARTICLE 6. BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

6.1. The club board of directors (referred to in these bylaws as "Board") consists of the president, immediate past president, president elect, Vice-President, treasurer, secretary, vice president(s), (if any), and all directors, and such other positions as may be required by the laws of local jurisdiction.

## CLUB POLICIES ("Kiwanis Club of Grand Junction" K02144) Mandatory Club Policies

A. CLUBS DUES AND FEES Currency USD

- 1. Annual dues amount: 360 \$536.00
- 2. New member enrollment fee amount:: Standard members and KEG members induction fee of \$50 and Business Members induction fee of \$250.00. The Club dues covers both Kiwanis International and District dues and fees.
- 3. Other amount(s), if any: Item: All members are required to sell at least 2 books of Pancake Day tickets or an equal amount or more in corporate sales for pancake day. Amount: 120

#### C. OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

- 1. This club has: 1 office of Vice-President.
- 2. This club has: 7 directors
- 3. A vacancy in the office of president shall be filled by: president elect-Vice President

#### **Optional Club Policies**

- 1. This club meets: weekly as follows: (Examples: "Every Monday at 11:30 am"; or "1st and 3rd Wednesday at 7:30am.") Every Thursday at 12:00 pm
  - 2. Club satellite meeting (if any): Kiwanis Enterprise Group (KEG) TBD

#### **PROPOSED DUES CHANGES**

Dues decreased a few years ago by \$40. We are operating partially from reserves.

Due to the \$25 increase in dues to Kiwanis International, your Board is proposing to reinstate the \$40. Annual Dues would change from \$320.00 to \$360.00. This equates to a \$3.33 increase per month.



#### Responsibilities of the Kiwanis Club of Grand Junction

#### 1. Volunteer Support:

 Provide volunteers to help with selling beer tickets, checking IDs, and putting on wristbands for patrons on Friday September 27 and Saturday, September 28.

#### 2. Set Up and Signage:

 Assist in putting up fencing, banners and the required event signage for both beer garden areas, including notices that no alcohol shall be brought past designated points, ID check requirements, and other state-required signage for the liquor license.

#### 3. Committee Meeting Participation

 If possible, have a member of Kiwanis attend the monthly committee meetings to stay in contact about beer garden plans.

#### **Financial Agreement**

The Chamber and Kiwanis agree to be partners in operating the Fruita Fall Festival beer garden.

Net proceeds from the beer garden, after covering all expenses (including beer, cups, liquor license, additional security, fencing, etc.), will be split 60/40 between the Chamber and the Kiwanis, with the Chamber receiving 60% and Kiwanis receiving 40%.
