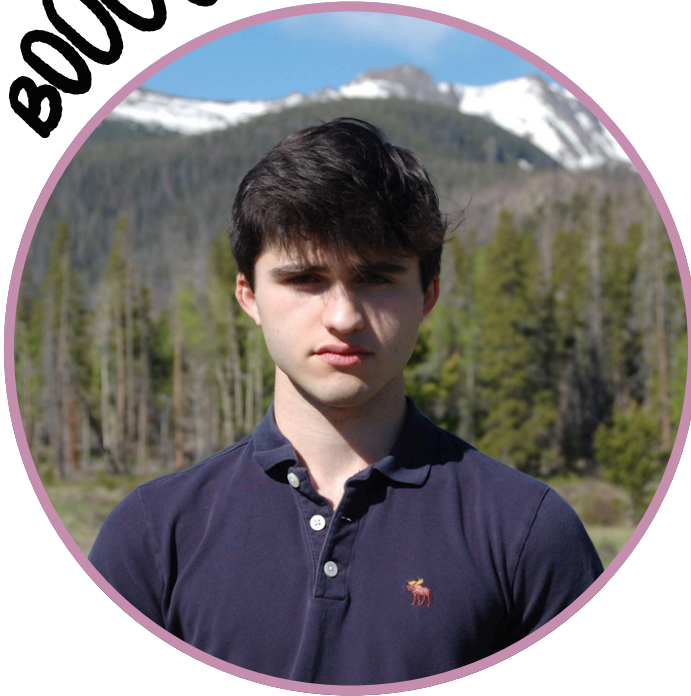

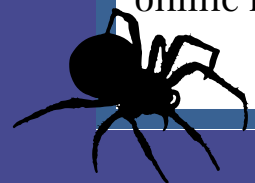

Thirst Project hopes to educate the next generation by arming students with information about how they can be a part of social change, make a difference and encourage others to join in the effort.

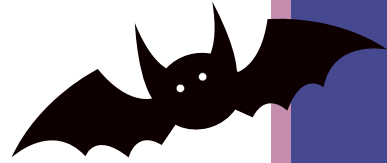


How to Pay Dues and Update Club Roster

Club Roster

Use Key Club's online Membership Update Center to ensure that your club's information and payments are updated. The faculty advisor and the club's president, secretary, and treasurer can access the online system.

1. Go to the MUC at www.keyclub.org/MUC
2. Type in account information or register for an account



Make sure that you collect each member's email address and expected year of graduation to be entered into the system.

After you've made your account and have your member information, advisors will have to add or update the club's president, secretary, and treasurer so they are able to access the system. Advisors are able to through the Members tab within the MUC.

When you're updating your club's roster, do not replace the whole roster and upload members as "new" members; only delete unpaid members or those who are not returning.

If your club needs to change a faculty advisor or member, name contact Member Services.

Dues

Log into the Kiwanis Connect site (where the MUC webpage is located), and select "Complete roster/print invoice" to create a club invoice. Double check and make sure that your club's roster information is accurate and up to date beforehand.

From there, you'll be able to pay for club dues directly.





Key Club Week

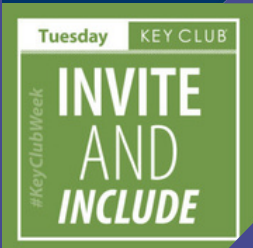


November 4th-8th is Key Club Week! Make sure to celebrate this club this week by participating in the day themes from International. Make sure to tag the District in all your posts!

Connect the Ks! Collaborate with other clubs in the Kiwanis family for joint service projects or events.





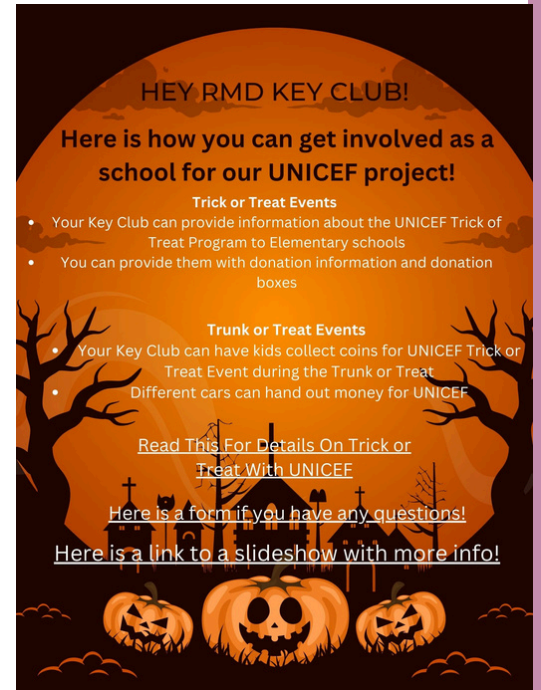
District Project

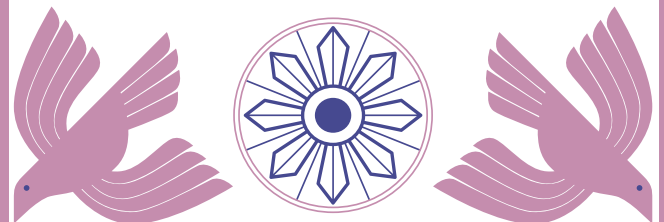


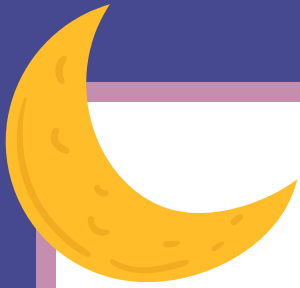
SAVE THE DATE!

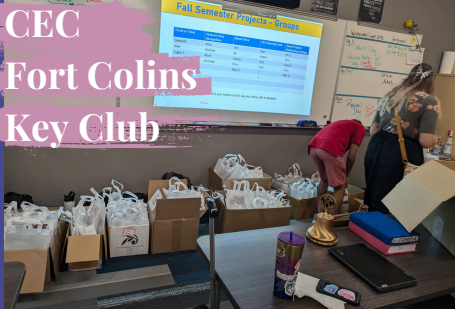

- SERVICE HOURS**
If your school has required service hours, remind students that Key Club is an excellent way to get those hours!
- SIGNATURE PROJECT**

- BUILDERS CLUB**
