Meals on Wheels

I am sure that Ken mentioned this to you at meetings, but I remind you. Several key volunteers have had to take their names off our Meals on Wheels list because of health issues. We need more volunteers!!! Before I make the quarterly schedule out, I send a request for you to tell me the dates you are unavailable to avoid conflicts. We could sure use your help with Meals on Wheels volunteering. As of now, we deliver Route 18 every day of the month except 2. please email me at Riggs39@aol.com or call me on my cell phone on 303.489. 0898 if this interests you.

So, this is how a typical day works:

You are teamed up with another Kiwanian or a family member if you wish. There are always two folks who

volunteer each day. About 9:30 am you would drive to Meals on Wheels location at Arapahoe RD and just east of Broadway to pick up the Meals. **They supply you with a client list, addresses and a suggested route.**

At the center you sign in on a slate with your route number 18. This indicates you are there. Your meals to deliver are brought out in an insulated bag and they announce the Route number. Ours is Route 18. You generally depart the center between 10 am and 10:30 am. Usually, one person drives and the other bags up the meals in plastic bags and delivers them to the door of the client. Hopefully we will visit a moment with the client, if they wish.

We are usually finished by 12:30 pm so our total time is about 3 hours. The only thing that is required by Meals on Wheels to be a volunteer is an application (Meals on Wheels provides), and a copy of our driver's license and Proof of Insurance.

If you decide to help, you will be rewarded, I can assure you. These clients are so appreciative of the meals and the short visit. You will go home "just feeling good" about the experience. As you heard from other volunteers, we have become very attached to some of these clients.

Most of our volunteers drive and deliver 2 or 3 times per quarter. I do the scheduling, but I always find out first each



volunteer's availability. Each quarter I send out the schedule. If you are interested, I can team you up for a "trial run" with some other volunteers first, if you would like to do that. - Riggs Smith
