Meals on Wheels Schedule

Riggs is in the process of making the new Meals on Wheels driver schedule. I think he also needs a big thank you for this scheduling and his presentations at the meetings.

Meals on Wheels! The delivery of hot meals to (mostly) Senior Citizens is one of our Kiwanis Club's main projects.

I am the contact for this project, and the purpose of this letter is -- we need more people to participate. It is very rewarding, and only takes part of a day, 2 or 3 times every three months, so please consider volunteering.

It's easy. On the date you are assigned, you will work with a fellow Kiwanian. We work in pairs, and usually one person drives while the other gets the next delivery ready. Some of us work with another Kiwanian, and others work with our spouses or friends

We go to the Nourish Meals on Wheels facility at 92 East Arapahoe Road, near the corner of Broadway and Arapahoe Road. We arrive about 9:30 a.m., sign in, and pick up the meals and route. Ours is Route 18 and we usually have 11-15 addresses to deliver.

After picking up the meals, we follow the route sheet and deliver the meals. Usually, we are done by 12:30 or 1 p.m. The bags that the meals were packed in can either be taken to a Kiwanis meeting and turned over to the next set of drivers, or can be brought to my house and I will take them back.

Most of our clients have been on the route for a long time and after you work Route 18 a time or two, it gets easy. I will schedule you to "ride along" on the route with a current driver to "get acquainted" with the process of getting the meals, and the route itself. Some of the clients like to visit, so we often visit for a few minutes. This may be the only human contact they have that day, so we encourage our volunteers to visit briefly. You will need to fill out an application to volunteer at Meals on Wheels, take a short tour of the facility, and provide proof of vehicle insurance.
