Speaker Craig Banister

Craig has been an amateur archaeologist for the last 12 years, doing site surveys and excavations in the state of Colorado. Five years ago, he and Neil Hauser, a professional archaeologist located in Montrose, started the Colorado Projectile Point Database project to create high resolution scans of projectile points from private collections and museum collections. They currently have over 13,000 images in their online database along with data for each one, for example, Material, Color, Shape, Serration, Flaking Pattern, and so on. Their goal is to scan as many Colorado collections as possible for inclusion in the database, to aid students as well as amateur and professional archaeologists in research.
