### Dove, Inc. Trivia and Program Details

- Dove founded in 1970; RSVP program joined in 1976.
- RSVP: Retired Senior Volunteer Program; minimum age 55.
- RSVP volunteers served over 90,000 hours last year; cannot drive school buses.
- Dove operates six year-round programs in Mayhem County, including RSVP and Domestic Violence Program.
- Dove Financial Assistance provides up to \$300 per request, paid directly to vendors.

### **Funding Challenges and Community Support Discussion**

- Domestic violence program anticipates 40% funding loss over next two years.
- Severe budget cuts expected for related programs.
- RSVP enrollment and timesheet reporting can help programs document support to Congress.
- Ongoing need to assess and maintain support for affected programs.

### **Community Fund and Volunteer Activities**

- Illinois Eats program terminated; previously enabled local food purchases from Illinois growers.
- Community fund no longer supports Illinois Eats.
- Ongoing support activities for Dove, including monthly item collection for Dove domestic quidance program and God's Shelter of Love.
- Volunteers provide food to Careage House and serve at Good Samaritan Inn.

### **Dove Office Info and Program Partnerships**

- Main office located at 302 South Union Street.
- Programs include Domestic Violence Program, Homework Bound, RSVP, Babes, Dove Financial Assistance, Neighborhood Services, Christmas Care & Share, Coats for Kids, Children's Clothing Room at Central Christian Church.
- Partnerships exist with multiple agencies, not all are part of Dove.
- Homeward Bound building referenced as a key facility.
