#### MRI's Mission, Programs, and Personal Stories

- Kyle Carston, Director of Development at MRI, previously worked 9 years at Salvation Army.
- MRI (Macon Resources) mission: promote growth, independence, self-worth for persons with disabilities.
- Organization history: founded 1958 as Progress Resource School by parents; merged facilities in 1988 to form Macon Resources; current facility built 1991.
- Programs focus on employment, business partnerships, and community integration for persons served.

### History, Growth, and Community Integration of MRI

- About **200** individuals with developmental disabilities attend daily programs at MRI.
- Day training includes life skills (kitchen, laundry) and socialization to support independent living.
- Employment programs include job assessment, training, and partnerships with businesses (e.g., license plate production, shredding, cleaning services).
- Clinical services provided by **4 registered nurses** and behavioral services staff; human rights advocacy included.
- MRI operates **9 group homes** for supported independent living; also offers services for children (speech, autism, social skills) and supports Special Olympics participation.

#### **Business Partnerships, Events, and Community Support**

- MRI supports individuals with developmental disabilities through events and community engagement.
- Annual events include a September golf outing, Disability Employment Awareness Month in October, and "Paint the Town Orange" for Disabilities Awareness Month in March.
- Field Day and outdoor activities at Meaningful Meadows promote inclusion and community participation.
- December initiative supports 85 individuals in group or independent living with holiday wish lists and gifts.
- Opportunities exist for financial support and volunteering to impact the lives of those served by MRI.

The commander searched for the previous commander's phone number to ask him why he posted guards at this particular bench.


"I don't know. The previous commander had guards there, and I kept the tradition."
