Pete Buckley's FBI Career and Major Cases

- Pete Buckley served as FBI special agent for **24 years**, with prior roles as deputy sheriff, Army officer, and National Guard member.
- Persistently applied to FBI, accepted in 1986; inspired by his father, a former FBI agent (1951–1956).
- Worked major cases: undercover in INF Treaty compliance, Chicago gang task forces, high-profile kidnappings, and murder-for-hire investigations.
- Utilized federal wiretap laws to target gang leadership, resulting in large drug and cash seizures (e.g., \$1.7 million in one case) and life sentences for violent offenders.
- FBI gang squads in Chicago remain active due to ongoing drug trade and gang violence; federal statutes enable longer sentences and more effective investigations.
