CRITERIA

- Students interested in applying for a Kiwanis Educational Grant or Larry Frew Memorial scholarship may do so beginning January 15, 2026.
- The deadline for applying for this scholarship is Friday, May 15, 2026. All completed applications must be postmarked through U. S. mail by this date. Mail to: Kiwanis – Kansas City – West - 12137 Hubbard Rd Kansas City, KS 66019
- Scholarship funding is limited and meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee scholarship selection.
- All High School Seniors who live and are attending an accredited high school in Wyandotte County are eligible to apply.
- Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher to be eligible.
- This is a one-year scholarship, with no provisions for renewal.
- Scholarship payout will be divided between Fall and Spring semesters.
- **A completed application includes:**
 1. **Grant application filled out,**
 2. **A letter of recommendation from a school or activity representative (cannot be a family member)**
 - 3 **A sealed original/ official transcript**
 4. **Essay**

Awards

- Up to six Educational Grants will be awarded for \$1000.00 each.
- One individual may be awarded the Larry Frew Memorial Scholarship for \$2000.00. (Must be a member of the Piper High School Key Club)
