Note for New and Renewing Member Dues: The Nebraska-Iowa District is a Tier A Nation and annual membership dues and fees to International is \$82. Of that \$82, dues are \$52 and fund meeting expenses, membership materials, shipping, grants, technology infrastructure and other expenses. In the U.S. and Canada, member fees are \$8 for the Kiwanis magazine, \$18 for member liability insurance and \$4 for directors and officers insurance. Annual membership dues for the Nebraska-Iowa District are \$40 and help to cover meeting and travel expenses for district, region and division officers; Service Leadership Program support; training, education and development; and other district expenses.
