## Nebraska-lowa Bylaw Amendment 1 Election of District Trustees Article 3, Section 2

## Proposed by: District Board

**Purpose:** To allow a qualified past It. governor from outside of a region to serve as a trustee, if no one from within the region is willing or able to serve.

## Proposed Effective Date: Oct. 1, 2025

Financial Impact: Limited (potential mileage reimbursement increase)

## Additions to Article 3, Section 2, item c as <u>underlined</u>. No deletions.

c. Each Trustee shall be a member\*\* of a club\* in the region from which elected; shall have served as a Lieutenant Governor of a division within the region and shall be endorsed as a candidate by board of the candidate's primary club. However, if there is no member\*\* from a club\* in a particular region qualified and willing to serve as trustee, a past Lieutenant Governor endorsed by their club in another region may serve.

Be it known, the Nebraska-Iowa District Board supports the passage of this amendment and sends it to a vote at the Nebraska-Iowa House of Delegates annual meeting on Aug. 2, 2025 in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Amendment No. 1 was approved by the Nebraska-Iowa District Board, April 26, 2025.
