



STANDING RULES FOR THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES

Rule 1

The official language of the Convention shall be English.

Rule 2

Only official delegates may be able to speak on motions and vote.

Rule 3

No delegate may speak more than three (3) minutes at a time, unless allowed to do so by the orders of the day or by a majority vote of the delegates.

Rule 4

No delegate may address the attendees a second time on the same question until the delegates who desire to speak on the topic have spoken.

Rule 5

Candidates for the office of Coordinator, Coordinator Elect and Vice Coordinator shall have a nomination speech not to exceeding one (1) minute, and shall personally address the House of Delegates for no more than three (3) minutes.

Rule 6

Any candidate who is unopposed for office must be elected by applause.

Rule 7

Any of the above rules may be suspended by majority vote.
