

Proposed Ammendment I

Extension of Grant for Members 18 - 40 years old for three years (1st October 2025 - 31st September 2028)

Purrpose: To encourage new and younger membership to impact growth for
Kiwanis United Kingdom

Effective date: October 1st 2025

The Kiwanis UK board supports this ammendment

- Reducing district dues by £20 lowers the financial barrier for young members aged 18–40, making Kiwanis membership more accessible at a stage in life when budgets can be tight.
- By supporting younger members now, the organisation invests in developing future leaders who can carry forward Kiwanis' mission and values for decades to come.
- Growth through younger membership is in line with Kiwanis Internationals drive to increase membership

Extract from Kiwanis UK Policies & Procedures:

IX. 1.5 The district shall allow clubs to submit for a grant of £20 for young professionals. These are members age 18 to 39 to encourage young professional memberships for the period of 1st October 2020 to 31st September 2023 (Three years trial). (08/20) Extend the Young Professional UK grant for the discount of £20 for district dues for ages 18– 40 for the period 1st October 2022 to 31st September 2025 (Another Three years). Note clubs can choose to pass on the discount to the member or continue to include the £20 in the invoice to the member. (08/22) Extend the Young Professional UK grant for the discount of £20 for district dues for ages 18– 40 for the period 1st October 2025 to 31st September 2028 (Another Three years).
