Our Club Meetings.

Welcome aboard. You have joined a great organization. The following are a few guide lines to acquaint you with our club.

Our Club meets every Wednesday from 12 to 1 PM at CJ's HighMarks on 211 Irmischer Blvd in Celina. **Because of the Covid-19 pandemic we meet only twice per month, the first and third Wednesday of each month.**

The meetings are usually held in the party room unless posted otherwise.

Meals are \$7 per person and can be pre-paid on an annual basis.

The guest speaker's meals are paid by the club and the meal of a member's guest is paid for by the member bringing the guest.

The first Wednesday of every month is reserved for the Board of Director's meeting and no program will be presented.

The remaining meetings will have the following format:

12:00 to 12:30 PM lunch and casual conversation among members and guests. 12:30 to 12:40 PM opening of the meeting and announcements. 12:40 PM to 1:00 PM program. 1 PM meeting adjourns. **During the Covid-19 pandemic programs are suspended.**

During the regular meeting we ask for happy/sad dollars. Members donate a dollar if they had something good or bad happen to them during the preceding week. The collection box is opened at the end of the year and the club decides what to do with the collected money. Donations are entirely voluntary.

It is understood that not every member can attend every meeting but we hope you will attempt to attend as many meetings as possible.

Our club was chartered on November 27th 2001.

We are constantly striving to attract new members.

Governance.

The club bylaws are published in the Members section of our web-site at “Club Bylaws”.

The Board of Directors meets the first Wednesday of each month. It is made up of the President, President-Elect, Vice President, Immediate Past President, and 6 elected board members. The term of the elected members is 2 or 3 years.

We have the six basic committees as outlined in the bylaws. They are listed in our web-site in the “Members Section” section. Every member is encouraged to belong to at least one committee.

The election of officers and board members is on the second Wednesday in May of each year. A nomination committee will provide the candidates

Our Financing.

Our Club Dues are \$120.

Some of our fund-raising projects are the “Reindog” event, the Lake fest food stand. The Club Treasurer maintains two accounts, the Foundation account which holds monies that can only be dispensed for charitable uses, and an Administrative account for everything else.

Our Community Service.

We perform various community services that impact the community as a whole, such as the annual Christmas parade, participation in "Earth-day", "Make A Difference Day", food and clothing donations to Our Home, sprucing up Harbor House, participation in the Lake Festival, helping with Freedom Days to name a few.
