THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL

Kiwanis is an international service organization founded in 1915 and focused on supporting youth.

In addition to 185,000 members in 8,000 adult clubs across the globe, Kiwanis offers three specific programs for youth: **Key Club, Builders Club** and **K-Kids**. Key Club is the oldest and largest service organization for teens and teaches leadership through service to others. Builders Club pro-



vides students age 11-14 with opportunities to develop leadership skills, improve self-esteem, increase civic engagement and learn life skills through

service. K-Kids gives students ages 6-12 opportunities to work together on service projects, develop leadership potential and create strong moral character.

There also are **Kiwanis Aktion Clubs** for adults with disabilities, as well as **Circle K International** for college and university students.

Globally, Kiwanis and its members raise almost \$340 million and dedicate more than 7.3 million hours annually to strengthen communities and help children throughout the world.

- Arlington Pediatric Clinic: This organization provides services to mothers and their newborn babies to ensure a bright future lies ahead.
- Our Lady Queen of Peace Catholic Church Pantry: This church food pantry provides vital support to those facing food-insecurity in our community.
- St. George's Episcopal Church Pantry: An outreach effort to support those challenged by food-insecurity, with a history of service dating back 35 years.
- Arlington Community Foundation: From scholarship programs to grants to research projects, the Arlington Community Foundation for 30-plus years has focused on key issues affecting the community, and brought together stakeholders to address them.
- **Kiwanis District Foundation:** The district foundation provides grants to organizations across the region, and serves as a conduit between local clubs and international efforts.
- Kiwanis Children's Fund: Across the globe, the Kiwanis Children's Fund targets its efforts on projects that improve the lives of youth in some of the world's most impoverished areas.
