

## Missouri-Arkansas District of Kiwanis International District Board Meeting Minutes

August 5, 2021 – 3:15pm

- 1. Governor Elect Carla O'Brien called the meeting to order at 3:25pm.

- 4. Governor Elect Carla O'Brien Introduces our new Trustees to the Board. Mary Saale, Region IV and Gary Baker, Region VIII (absent).
- 5. Governor Elect Carla O'Brien asked the board to approve the reappointments of District Secretary Mary Vaughan and District Treasurer Robin Asher for the Kiwanis Year 2021-2022. Les Mace motioned the approve, Mary Saale seconded: All approved.

The board discussed the criteria and felt they needed to separate the Service Leadership requirement of sponsoring a SLP with the giving guidelines. So, this made a seventh requirement titled giving guidelines. Les Mace motioned to approve the changes, Thom South seconded: all approved.

They also adopted criteria for a Distinguished Lt. Governor, which are:

- a. Conducting a club officer education program
- b. Net gain in membership in the division
- c. Opening a new club in the division
- d. Supporting another division in opening a new club
- e. A minimum of two (2) clubs recognized as Distinguished in the division.
