County Clerk Speaks About Election Security

Our own Shane Schoeller, Greene County Clerk, spoke to the club about election security ahead of the Aug. 2 primary election. Shane told us that both the ballots and counting machines are being tested now. His office will test 12,500 ballots by running them through machines to confirm the machines will properly read and tally the ballots. These test ballots are then hand counted for comparison to the readout from the machine. This process takes approximately 25 hours per machine.

If a voter is not available to go to the polls on election day, they can cast an absentee ballot. Shane said this can now be done in person by filling out their ballot and inserting it into one of the tabulating machines. After the polls close on election day, ballots are manually counted from 5 precincts chosen at random for comparison to the tally from the machines. Shane said in the 8 years this policy has been in place no hand count has ever differed from the machine count.

Election judges representing all political parties on the ballot will be present at polling place on election day, and watchers and challengers from all parties are present for manual counts. By having every party represented, they hold each other accountable. Shane said volunteers are needed for all of these positions, with training provided by the County Clerk's office.
