## Annual Prayer Luncheon

In recognition of the first Object of Kiwanis, "To give primacy to the human and spiritual, rather than the material values of life", our club held it's annual Prayer Luncheon on September 15. Special music for the event was provided by Rev. Corey Scott, Worship Minister for Northside Christian Church. Reverend Scott brought his guitar and led the club members in singing several hymns and praise songs.



The message was presented by Rev. Scott Watson, Pastor of River Bluff Fellowship. Reverend Watson titled his message "Look Who's Listening". He started with the observation that between talking and listening, it is much harder to listen. Listening, he said, is an art that takes patience and discipline. Sometimes people



asking for help just want to be heard, he noted, and when he is counselling someone and doesn't know what to say he will just listen. Rev. Watson said we can be glad that God listens to us when we pray. He closed his talk with the story of Elijah challenging the priests of Baal. Even though they tried all day, nothing happened at the altar of the

Baal priests and Elijah chided them and asked if their god was even there. But when Elijah prayed to God, not just the offering but the entire altar was consumed by Heavenly fire.
