### Kiwanis Club of Columbia & Kiwanis Club Foundation Minutes of Hybrid Board Meeting Held at The Rock Bridge HyVee Community Room and available via ZOOM November 15, 2022, 1:00 pm

**Meeting** was called to Order at 1:04 pm by President, Lynn Limback. Other Officers and Board Members present in person were Dennis Kastens, Janet Schisser, Ernest Hilderbrand, Norma Fair, and Dale Metcalf,. Clyde Bentley, Jack Meinzenbach, Gene Gerke, Jim Matteson and Cecilia Young were absent. There were no Non-Board members present. A quorum was declared.

**Minutes** from the last regular board meeting of October 18, 2022 had been distributed 10-25-22 and 11-14-22 via email. Janet pointed out that Dennis Kastens name had been inadvertently left off those attending in October, and that she will correct the minutes accordingly. Dale moved approval of the minutes as corrected, Ernest seconded, and approval was unanimous.

#### **Financial Reports:**

- Treasurer Hilderbrand had previously distributed Club and Foundation Financial Reports as of November 14, 2022 via email. He pointed out a needed correction regarding the entries made for payment of 2022-23 SLP renewals in Budget year 2021-22, and he will discuss with Janet after the meeting. After discussion, Dennis moved acceptance of Treasurer's Report when corrected, Dale seconded the motion and approval was unanimous.
  - Ernest shared a request from Kiwanis Children's Fund for 2022-23 donations in excess of what our normal amount has been. Janet moved we send them the normal \$10.00 per member since we have budgeted \$1,000 for a Hixson award in the spring. Dale seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- The Memorial Trust Fund Report for October 2022 was presented by Dale Metcalf. The total Portfolio value of the MTF overall increased \$9,685.34 in October to \$399,530.57 as of 10-31-22. Balance in the Central Bank Cash account remained at \$2,995.25 since there were no donations received in October. Ernest moved acceptance of the report, Dennis seconded and the motion was approved.
- A copy of all reports are attached to these minutes for the record.

**New Member Application –** A new member application from Ann Dieterle and a check for FY 2022/23 dues were presented by Secretary Janet who will be Ms. Dieterle's sponsor. Janet moved acceptance of the new member, Ernest seconded and the motion was approved.

### Administrative Items -

- Dennis Kastens reported that he had completed the review of the Club and Foundation financials and found no exceptions or problems. Janet moved acceptance of the report, Dale seconded and the motion was approved. An email confirming this is attached to these minutes for the records.
- Janet and Ernest reported that the preparation of Form 990 by Convergence Accounting LLC is in the final review state and should be submitted before the end of November.
- Discussion was held about reaffirming or revising the policy of cancelling the weekly inperson meeting based on closure of Columbia Public Schools due to snow. Ernest moved that we continue that policy but arrange a meeting via ZOOM instead. Janet seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously, subject to Lynn's approval of hosting the meeting from Central Bank.

### **Committee Reports:**

- Centennial celebration committee report: No update at this time.
- Fundraising committee report Cecilia Young had previously indicated to Lynn that she would schedule a meeting of her committee next week. Ernest reported a connection he is exploring to request a sponsorship from Veteran's United.

### President's topics:

- President Lynn reported that the President's Council will not meet until December. Little Dixie Club is in charge of Kiwanis One Day and is suggesting working in Wooldridge community in the spring. More will be reported later.
- Lynn announced that he will schedule the first evening Club meeting on November 29 possibly at Gunter Haus restaurant.
- No new reports on electronic dues paying, civic club projects, nor playground at Kiwanis Park
