Two Articles Passed at the Convention

The below articles were discussed, voted on and passed by the majority of delegates at the MO-ARK District Convention in August in Bentonville, Arkansas:

Article X. Revenue

Section 1. Each club shall pay annual dues to the district of twenty dollars (\$20.00) thirty dollars (\$30.00) for each active club member in an amount determined by a two thirds (2/3) vote of the district House of Delegates. Dues shall be based on each club's annual membership report to Kiwanis International as of September 30 of each year and shall be due annually on October 1 and payable by November 30.

Section 2. New member add fees are charged by the district in an amount determined by the House of Delegates. Prorated district dues shall be charged for each new member of a club on the same prorated schedule used by Kiwanis International. District dues shall be charged for each new member of a club on the same basis used by Kiwanis International.

Article III. Officers.

Section 2. Each district officer shall be an active member in a club of the district. Each Lieutenant Governor shall be a member of a club in the division from which elected and each Trustee shall be a member of a club in the region from which elected and have previously served as a Lieutenant Governor. Each district officer shall be an active member in a club of the district. Each trustee shall be a member of a club in the region from which elected and have previously served as a Lieutenant Governor. Each Lieutenant Governor shall be a member of a club in the division from which elected. However, if there is no member from a club in a particular division qualified and willing to serve as a Lieutenant Governor, a member of a club in another division may serve. The Governor and Governor-elect shall have and maintain a clear criminal history background check conducted and verified by Kiwanis International.
