Rick stated that The Mehlville Early Childhood Center is having an event called "Things That Go" this coming Saturday, 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM. We are all invited to attend and hand out Fairy Houses. Rick and Jeanne will be attending. Louann stated that this past Monday she gave the Mehlville Key Club the \$1,000.00 check from our club. She said they were very excited. Louann also encouraged them to apply for the \$500.00 Earl Collins Key Club grant. Thanks Louann!

Dr. Haug thanked everyone for the opportunity to join us. He stated that he grew up in St Charles but has many family members from the Mehlville District. Education is in his blood. Both his parents and his wife are in education fields. He was excited to take this position, Superintendent, because of the community, teachers, and kids. Mehlville is recognized nationally as an Innovative School. Innovative schools are the top districts in the nation. The district currently has 800 teachers, 64 administrators and 520 support staff. The district has 103 buses and transports 7000 students. 73% of the teachers have master's degree. Prop E enabled the district to have a teachers pay scale equal to the top districts in St Louis. This is a tremendous advantage for keeping teachers. There were 800 graduates last year. This is an amazing number. Emphasis is placed on making sure each and every student feels connected. The school is a District of Character, emphasizing responsibility and respect. The District of Character is a national certification and the highest honor given by Character.Org. The district has a Tech school which currently has 64 students. Students must apply to go to the tech school. Many students graduate from tech school with a job already in place. Thank you Dr. Haug for the great presentation!
