

Distinguished Clubs 2022-2023

There are two ways that a club can achieve distinguished status. One is that they reach specific goals and submit for themselves. The second way is to be named by their Lt. Governor. Thus, a division can have multiple clubs submit for themselves and one club named by the Lt. Governor.

OPTION 1: Club achieves and submits to district executive secretary by November 15.

All four areas are required:

Membership — Net increase in membership OR sponsorship of a new Kiwanis club.

Education — Participate in President Club Leader Education AND participate in Secretary Training.

Community Impact — Sponsor at least one Service Leadership Program club/Key Leader/WILS.

Image — Submit all 12 Monthly Report Forms.

OPTION 2: Nominated by Lt. Governor. Lt. Governor submits to District Executive Secretary by November 15.

- The club stayed engaged with their members by meeting consistently.
- The club showed a strong commitment to service.
- The club showed a commitment to membership growth by inviting potential new members.
- The club started new service project(s).
- The club was a strong supporter of their Service Leadership Programs/Key Leader.
- The club encouraged education of members by attending midyear conferences, convention, leader education, district membership and education sessions, division council meetings.
- The club supported and interacted with their Lt. Governor.
- The club supported other clubs by attending other clubs' events, helping other clubs.
