

Rules & Regulations

- Two Tiers: Tier 1 27 or less members; Tier 2 28 or more members
- Club level projects submitted online directly to KI
 - Timeframe for submission, review, and selection to be determined
- KI sends submissions to District Secretary
- The District (Capital) designs the process for selecting club-level projects.
- Committee notifies the Governor and KI of selected projects
- KI Board Committee on Service and Partnerships reviews qualifying submissions and select the finalists.
