

2026-27 Capital District Kiwanis Interclub Contest

All clubs in the Capital District are eligible to participate in the 2026-27 Interclub contest. Clubs will compete in categories based on the Kiwanis International policy on the number of members required for an interclub

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| a. Club with 30 or more members (4 members needed) | Red Division |
| b. Club with 21-29 members (3 members) | White Division |
| c. Club with 20 or less members (2 members) | Blue Division |

Interclub entries will be made on the club's monthly report entered by the Club Secretary in Kiwanis Engage. This will be the only way clubs will be judged for this contest.

The Capital District Achievement Committee will review and score all interclubs submitted by the clubs using the Interclub Scoring Matrix

<u>Interclub Type</u>	<u>Points per member</u>
1. Interclub with other Kiwanis Clubs	1 points
2. Interclub with service leadership programs scheduled meetings <u>(Note: Host K family members may not be used to complete the interclub)</u>	2 points
3. Interclub at:	
a. Division Council Meeting	2 points
b. New Club Charter Night	2 points
c. Service Leadership Programs events (ex: Key Club, CKI, Builders, K-Kids) (includes conventions, rallies, training sessions, council meetings)	2 points
d. Club events designated by the Lt. Governor: (examples)	
• SLP Celebration	4 points
• Steak Fry	4 points
• Pancake Breakfast	4 points
<u>(Note: Lt. Governors will designate events that will encourage Kiwanis Clubs to visit functions in large numbers and submit to the Achievement Committee.)</u>	
4. Inter-club at:	
a. Anytime a K family Governor or International President is present at a Kiwanis family function (replaces value for that event)	6 points
b. Mid-Year Conference or District Convention	6 points
c. Kiwanis International Convention	6 points
d. District Board of Trustees and District Foundation meeting	6 points
5. <u>Bonus Points</u>	<u>Points per inter-club visit</u>
a. Inter-club with all clubs in Division (Example: 11 clubs in a division count 10 bonus points when all club visits in a division are completed)	1 point per club visit
b. Any interclub outside division (including conferences)	4 points per visit
c. Inter-club over 50 miles one-way distance from your club meeting place	4 points per visit

Winning clubs will be recognized at the 2028 Mid Year Conference.
