KATHY: Acquire award medals and supply name tags.

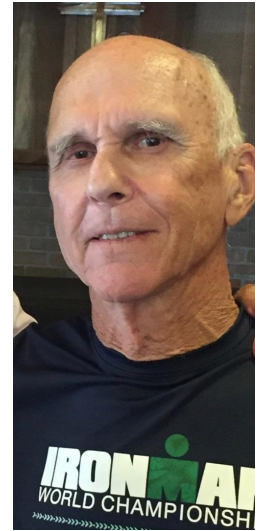
KEY CLUB ADVISERS: Contact Key Club members to invite them to attend the event and earn community service hours.
