PROGRAM

Our own Jerry Smith recounted his trip to Washington DC on August 20th of this year courtesy of [Honor Flight Chicago](#). Over 12,000 WW2, Korean, and Viet Nam era veterans have now taken part via Honor Flight Chicago who organizes 7 flights per year.

The day began early at 2 a.m. with a trip to Midway Airport and a Southwest Airlines flight to Dulles International outside of Washington DC and didn't conclude until 11 p.m. that night when Jerry finally arrived back home. Along with Jerry on the flight was Sycamore Resident Ed Kuhn.

The day was a whirlwind of activities and included stops at the WW2 Memorial, Korean and Viet Nam war memorials and the Marine Memorial on the National Mall followed by a visit to the National Air & Space Museum/[Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center](#) in Chantilly, VA.

Jerry was joined by a guardian who accompanied him the entire day and manned a wheelchair when necessary. Police blocked freeway entrances to ensure a safe and efficient bus trip to the various destinations.

The most moving moments came from the unexpectedly large crowds of well-wishes who cheered the veterans upon arrival at Dulles and their return to Midway. Mail call included letters, notes, and pictures from friends, relatives, and school children and was greatly appreciated, and possibly brought a couple of vets to tears.

We were also honored by the presence of Mike Embry who talked briefly about his Honor Flight in 2024. Always looking for ways to make a positive impact for the area, Mike is working to establish DeKalb as a flag city, and he referenced the repair of the Memorial Clock by the Rotary Club. Impressively, DeKalb County sent over 2,000 soldiers overseas during WW1.
