Eligible expenses include tuition, room and board, or books/supplies. The number of scholarships and the amount of each scholarship shall be decided by the Kiwanis Board of Directors annually and will be paid directly either to the recipients or to the recipients' choice of further education (at the sole discretion of the Hooksett Kiwanis Board of Directors). A selection panel shall be determined by the Hooksett Kiwanis Scholarship Committee to decide the recipient(s) of this scholarship. The members of the panel shall not be Hooksett Kiwanis members.
