The king of k East Meadow Kiwanis

"Kiwanis should be a positive influence in communities worldwide," Diane Krug said. And the East Meadow Kiwanis - for which she serves as president — is just that.

Throughout the year, Kiwanis plans event after event to raise funds for those in need. And when it's not their event, they're always there to lend a hand.

For the winter holidays, like Thanksgiving and Christmas, Kiwanis members always get together for their annual meal and gift drive-by.

Before its event starts, the club hosts its Secret Snowflake Toy Drive through December to collect toys and provide some great Italian meals from Borrelli's Italian Family Restaurant for each family. Gift cards are collected as well to give to the older kids. Stew Leonard's donated cookies last year to complete each meal.

Kiwanis partners with the school district to identify East Meadow families that are in need, which typically number anywhere between 75 and 100. Social workers from the schools will collect any meals and presents that remain.

"This is all about the holiday spirit," David Rothman, a Kiwanian who has been involved with the event for more than 20 years, said.

"It's sad when you see the same people on the regular, and they have something going on in their life that they just can't get out of. But knowing we helped somebody in need is just great."

Before the academic year begins, Kiwanis runs a school supply drive so kids who need it can start the school year off right with fresh

supplies. This past year, some 160 kids in the East Meadow School District were given a new backpack with everything they could need. Supplies and money are donated from local politicians, neighbors, and other organizations.

"I've seen the generosity go up over the years," said Jennifer Reinhardt, the immediate past president of East Meadow Kiwanis. "Any time that we do this, the community comes together — the businesses, organizations. I'm always so floored at the generosity of our community."

The club gets a list from each school in the district with how many backpacks they need. Once the backpacks are done, they get dropped off at the Salisbury Center, where they are then distributed to students who need them.

In the summer, there's no stopping the club. They host a pancake breakfast that collects funds for Kiwanis scholarships for deserving high school seniors, and to send underprivileged children to Kamp Kiwanis.

In August, the club holds its annual Steven J. Eisman Memorial Golf Outing. Kiwanians and their friends show up to hit the links in Eisenhower Park to raise money. Last year, the club used \$5,000 from the event to stock the McVey Mighty Market, a food pantry in McVey Elementary School for community members in need.

IN MEMORIAM HONORABLE NORMA L. GONSALVES 1934-2025



Norma L. Gonsalves grew up in Brooklyn, one of five children. Her mother became her role model. She loved both her parents, but she adored her father. She worked with him in their family bakery and restaurant. Her love of cooking and baking stems from this time. Some may remember the East Meadow Kiwanis spaghetti dinner where she taught and served up her great meatballs. Her family also owned a bakery where she learned how to bake, and she made the best cookies ever! She also learned during this time how to multi-task and set her goals.

Norma received her Bachelor of Arts degree in history from St. Joseph's College for Women and a Master of Arts degree from Hunter College and Brooklyn College. She was an educator for 25 years in the New York City school system. Norma taught English and introduced her students to plays

and shared her lifelong interest in the performing arts, encouraging several of her students to pursue acting careers. She was proud to see many of them appear over the years on television or in the theater in New York City. Many of her former students stayed connected with her!

Norma's passion and flair for teaching were matched by her interest in and devotion to the life of her community starting with the PTA in the East Meadow School system. She was one of the founders of CEMCO, the Council of East Meadow Community Organizations and spearheaded the Crime Watch program in East Meadow. Norma was very passionate about protecting the environment including the bird sanctuary located in East Meadow. She served on many local advisory committees such as the Nassau County Correctional Facility and the Town of Hempstead solid waste management efforts. After she retired from teaching, Norma became a community activist, was elected in 1997 to the Nassau County Legislature and served in the 13th Legislative District. In 2010, she became the Presiding Officer of the Nassau County Legislature.

Norma loved children the most. She was a longtime Kiwanis SLP advisor and served for many years on the East Meadow Kiwanis Scholarship committee. She enjoyed the class visits to her office in the legislature and gave tours of the historic Old Courthouse. Norma was a strong independent woman. She was honored by East Meadow Kiwanis as a Lifetime Member and was the recipient of countless awards during her lifetime in recognition of her many achievements. She was both a teacher and a mentor who left an indelible mark on many of those that knew her well. Her strength of character, compassion, leadership, and dedication were an inspiration to all.

Norma was married to the love of her life, John Gonsalves, and she was mother to three children, Gregg Gonsalves, Dana Gonsalves, Carin Gonsalves, and proud grandmother of four grandchildren

Norma energetic life was reminiscent of the energizer bunny. Her life was filled with the love of her family and her community and her passion for helping people and children was extraordinary. She always went above and beyond!

Norma was a good friend and is missed by many!

Fred graduated from Hamilton College in 1974 and attended Law School at Brooklyn Law School graduating in 1977. After passing the bar he practiced in many areas of law including trust and estates, construction contract, personal injury and business law. After practicing in these areas, Fred was a judge in Nassau County District Court. He was most proud of being Judge Hirsh. In addition to his law practice, Fred was on the Board of the East Meadow Jewish Center, East Meadow Kiwanis, a past President of Congregation Anshei Israel of Tucson and on the Board or Committees of any other organization that he was part of.

In March 1980, Fred met his future wife, Mindy Cohen. They were married in November 1981. They had two children, Carly and Neil.

Fred made friends wherever he went. Once you were his friend, there was nothing he wouldn't do for you. Other than his family and friends, Fred was a big fan of his New York Mets. Jets and Islanders.

IN MEMORIAM SDPLG MICKIE LEAMEY

1937-2025



Super Distinguished Past Lieutenant Governor Mickie Leamey was truly a woman ahead of her time. In 1987, she broke new ground as the first female member of the Long Island South Central Division, joining Kiwanis and setting a precedent for future generations. From the very beginning, Mickie demonstrated a passion for leadership and a deep commitment to learning everything she could about the business of Kiwanis.

Mickie's drive and dedication quickly propelled her up the leadership ranks. She served as Club President and, in 1995, made history yet again as the first female Lieutenant Governor representing the Long

Island South Central Division. Her trailblazing spirit did not stop there; she soon took on impactful leadership roles in the New York District, where she advised many Governors and provided invaluable guidance and support.

In 2003, Mickie was named the first K Kids Administrator for the New York District, launching an era of service and mentorship that would span more than two decades. As an ambassador to the K Kids program for 22 years, Mickie mentored countless students, empowering them to thrive within the Service Leadership Program. Her legacy is deeply rooted in the lives of the children she inspired and guided.

Mickie's commitment extended beyond her leadership roles. She served on the New York District Foundation Board and the New York Pediatric Lyme Disease Board, further demonstrating her dedication to service and community. As President of the Long Island South Central Past Lieutenant Governors Council, she continually fostered a spirit of camaraderie and support among her peers.

Perhaps most notably, Mickie was always there to advise and guide leaders within the Kiwanis community. There was no issue too complex or topic too daunting for Mickie to offer her perspective and counsel. She was known for her willingness to reach out, share advice, and support others—her passion for service evident in every conversation and action.

We are forever grateful to Mickie Leamey. She was a true champion for the students in our Service Leadership Programs, and her influence will live on through the legacy of the children and families in East Meadow and beyond, all of whom she supported with unwavering strength and compassion. Mickie's dedication, leadership, and mentorship have left an indelible mark on our community, and she will be remembered always as a pioneer and role model for all who value service and leadership.


