Nathan Tsai was born in Glendale and raised in Alhambra before moving with his family to San Marino, is the youngest Californian to ever run for a CA State Assembly seat, and one of the youngest in the nation to run for a State House position.

At Claremont McKenna College, Tsai (a government major) was active in the College Republican Club; he was a Cadet in the U.S. Army ROTC program, and was a swimmer on the Claremont Mudd Scripps Intercollegiate Swim and Dive team.

At age 18, He became the youngest candidate to ever run for state office in California, earning 41% of the vote in the 2014 CA General Election against an incumbent career politician. With less than \$4,000 in my war chest, Nathan earned 43,126 votes.

Nathan spent 6 months on Capitol Hill working for House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy (R-CA), and the rest of 2015 working for LA County Supervisor Mike Antonovich and Chief of Staff Kathryn Barger.

As the Deputy Campaign Manager, He spent 18 months to help ensure that (now incumbent) Supervisor Kathryn Barger would be elected to the position in November 2016.

At age 22, he founded one of the first eSports/Gaming Production companies: Dreamleague Gaming. He produced large scale eSports events for colleges, conventions (SXSW, CES, Anime Expo).

He is currently working on several projects in healthcare/homelessness and also in brand marketing.

Nathan swam competitively for 10 years of his life and achieved the rank of Eagle Scout at age 15.

None of this would have been possible without a great education at Claremont McKenna College.
