Paul Little was appointed president and chief executive officer of the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce in December, 2007.

Previously, he was a senior account executive with VMA Communications, Inc., a boutique public relations and communications firm and provided all manner of communication-related work for school districts, public agencies, colleges and universities and other clients.

Mr. Little has served as Director of Communications for Claremont School of Theology and Pacific Asia Museum. Prior to entering the public relations arena, Mr. Little worked in the entertainment industry.

Mr. Little served on the Pasadena City Council from 1995 to 2007. He chaired the city's Finance Committee and served on the Municipal Services Committee and the Economic Development and Technology Committee. He served on the Board of the Los Angeles to Pasadena Metro Construction Authority from its inception in 1998 through completion of the initial, \$700 million construction phase

of the Gold Line light rail project in 2006. He served as chair of that board three times. Paul Little served on the Board of the Rose Bowl Operating Company and the Pasadena Center Operating Company that oversees the convention center and visitor's bureau. He is also on the Board of the Los Angeles County Business Federation (BizFed) and the Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce.

Mr. Little's wife Laurie Bollman-Little, a retired program coordinator and teacher with Los Angeles Unified School District, passed away in 2019. They have two children, Cameron who lives in Brooklyn and Courtney who is working for a regional theater in New Jersey. The Little family also includes Maggie, a Great Pyrenees dog.
