<u>Meetings – Kiwanis Live meeting with Zoom option, Thursday, October</u> 7th Dr. Michael Ressler - the James Webb Space Telescope at the <u>Salvation Army from 12:00 to 1:30 PM</u>



After over 20 years in development, the James Webb Space
Telescope is set to launch in December. Webb is a successor to the Hubble Space Telescope and will help astronomers understand how the first stars and galaxies formed after the Big Bang, how stars and planets form in our own Galaxy, and whether planets around nearby stars harbor the materials needed to support life. Dr. Michael Ressler is the JPL Project Scientist for one of the four instruments that will fly on the Webb Telescope. He will describe the observatory, some of the questions we hope Webb will answer, and the many partnerships that were needed to develop it
