<u>Kiwanis meeting – Thursday, October 6, 2022 – 12:00 – 1:30 PM – Dr.</u> <u>Michael Ressler, JPL Project scientist – Update on James Webb Space</u> <u>Telescope - 960 East Walnut Street, Pasadena, CA 91106</u>



After over 20 years in development, the James Webb Space Telescope launched in December 2021. Webb is a successor to the Hubble Space Telescope and will help astronomers understand how the first stars and galaxies formed after the Big Bang, how stars and planets form in our own Galaxy, and whether planets around nearby stars harbor the materials needed to support life. Dr. Michael Ressler is the JPL Project Scientist for one of the four instruments that will fly on the Webb Telescope. He will describe provide an update on the status and new discoveries provided by the James Webb Space Telescope.
