Christina started her career as a SLPA 10 years ago in a private clinic setting, where she assisted primarily with children ages 0-3 who were referred by regional centers within the Los Angeles County. Many of her clients had never been in a therapy setting and she quickly had to learn to be adaptable and flexible, as each child had different needs and methods of connecting. While challenging, it was incredibly rewarding to see what they were capable of after she built a connection. She quickly learned to love early intervention- it allowed her to play multiple roles with the children and form great relationships within 1:1 therapy format.

Christina now works full time in the school setting with students from pre-school to middle school setting. Which has also given her even more of a range of how much she can do in the field. She particularly enjoys working with students on inferencing abilities, expanding their

vocabularies through context clue work, and addressing social pragmatic skills. She enjoys building a connection with her students and clients by magnifying their strengths.

When she is not doing therapy, you can find her outside on an adventure. She loves to backpack in the Sierras, taking road trips exploring new places, and spending time with her family.

1. **Villa Esperanza Services** – we work with this organization to help disabled adults in Pasadena improve their self-esteem and help them to give back to their community through the **Aktion Club**.
2. **Salvation Army** – we ring bells during the Christmas season each year to raise money for their charity. We fill backpacks for students of low-income families. We also participate in the Adopt-a-Family Program.
3. **Elizabeth House** – working with homeless, young mothers and their children through support and hope.
