Dr. David Sadava
Speaker for our Luncheon on Saturday, September 4th

David Sadava is Adjunct Professor in the Department of Cancer Biology at the City of Hope Medical Center and Pritzker Professor of Biology, Emeritus, at The Keck Science Center, Claremont, California.

Dr. Sadava graduated from Carleton University as science medalist. A Woodrow Wilson Fellow, he received a Ph.D. in cellular biology from the University of California at San Diego. Following research at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography, he joined the faculty at Claremont. He has been a visiting professor at the University of Colorado and at the California Institute of Technology. He currently serves as an Advisory Board member at the Keck Graduate Institute and at the UCLA Center for Society and Genetics and is a trustee emeritus of Western University of Health Sciences.

A bench scientist throughout his career, he has held numerous research grants and written over 60 peer-reviewed scientific research papers. For the past 30 years, his research has focused on resistance to chemotherapy in human lung cancer, with a view to developing new, plant and mold-based medicines to treat this disease. He is also a member of a research group overseeing a clinical trial and related laboratory studies on the effects of consumption of white button mushrooms on the progression of prostate cancer. Much of this work has been presented at clinical conferences and published in leading journals. He is the co-author of five books, including the twelfth edition of a leading biology textbook, "Life: The Science of Biology"; an innovative conceptual text, "Principles of Life"; and "Plants, Genes and Crop Biotechnology". Committed to educating the general public, he has presented innumerable public talks on biological topics and has given free public courses on cancer. He created two highly successful video series, "What Science Knows about Cancer" and "Understanding Genetics: DNA, Genes and Their Real-World Applications" for The Great Courses.


