<u>Cami Emerson</u> is a graduate of Columbia Central High School who plans to study nursing at Jackson College. She graduated with a 3.88 GPA, was a member of the National Honor Society, and played volleyball, bowling, and softball. She served on the Jackson Community Foundation's Youth Advisory Committee where she served food to the homeless, planted daffodils at parks, and volunteered at the John George Home.

Morgan Sprunger is a graduate of East Jackson High School and plans to study nursing at Baker College. She was valedictorian (having earned a 4.0 GPA), a member of the National Honor Society, played volleyball, track, and basketball. She volunteered at a camp for students who use augumentative devices, at Lyle Torrant during its field and track day, and at the Cascades Humane Society.


