**100**<sup>th</sup> **Birthday Celebration** — What a fun birthday party! We got to see the club museum display, eat a great meal, have birthday cake and sing to our hearts content! Some members even performed for the group — some who planned ahead and some who got volunteered on the spot! Take your family and friends to see our historical museum display as it will be in the museum through the middle of October. There are a lot of other cool displays there as well.

**Summer "KID'S MOVIES"** at the Michigan Theatre was once again a huge success! Thank you to Pat Kiessling and all the Kiwanians who participated. The average attendance was about 500 kids per week.

#### Safe Sitter Program

This spring our club gave \$1,500 to Tanya Brush for supplies to get the "Safe Sitter" program started in our community. A few girls in her Cadette Girl Scout troop, for their Silver Award project, have put in over 50 volunteer hours working with the community to raise awareness and funding. They raised a little over \$500 and purchased 2 additional infant and 2 additional child manikins. With our support, the program now has 5 infant and 6 child manikins and 5 soft bodied dolls. Tanya is making big progress with the program. Safe Sitter launched a new 2 hour class geared toward 4th - 6th grade students teaching how to be safe at home, preventing accidents, online safety, and introducing them to the Safe Sitter First Aid Chart and how to assess injuries.

**Playground Build at Kiwanis Park -** The Community Build starts at 8 am on Friday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, and runs until finished, which we hope to be around 12 noon.
