#### A Historical Tidbit

In mid October of 1968, a historic event occurred in our club. Our club president, Barney Miller, noted that several members were pilots and had their own aircraft so he proposed a 'flying interclub'. It was agreed that 3 planes would participate namely: Cessna – piloted by Bob Crary Jr., Beechcraft Bonanza – piloted by John Dobbin and a Navion – piloted by Bob Pioch. Each plane carried 3 passengers making a total of 12 Kiwanians for the interclub.

Leaving at 6:00AM from Reynolds field, their first destination was the Muskegan club since they met at their airport restaurant at 7:00AM> A large contingent met our members upon their arrival.

The noon destination was the Sault Ste Marie Club who met us at their airport and transported us to their meeting in a downtown hotel. We were treated like celebrities!

The third and last destination was the Owosso club who had a dinner meeting. Scheduling the flight at the height of Michigan color season was a nice bonus. Everyone agreed that the event was a resounding success! Later, a slide presentation of the trip was shared with our club.
