J. Mercer Barnett Fellowship

J. Mercer Barnett, a Birmingham lumber company owner and charter member of the Kiwanis Club of Birmingham, played a pivotal role in the early years of Kiwanis. He served as the first Governor of the Alabama-Florida District (1918–1919) and went on to become the fourth President of Kiwanis International (1920–1921).

During the 1919 Kiwanis International Convention held in Birmingham, Barnett was instrumental in transforming Kiwanis into a true service organization. He worked closely with local judicial and financial leaders to coordinate the purchase of Kiwanis from founder Allen Browne, a defining moment in the organization's history.

In recognition of Barnett's remarkable contributions, the Alabama Kiwanis Foundation Board established the **J. Mercer Barnett Fellowship** in 1995. This prestigious honor is awarded to individuals or organizations for outstanding leadership or significant contributions to community service.

The fellowship requires a donation of at least \$500, which can be made as a lump sum or over two years. Recipients who contribute an additional \$500 are elevated to the distinguished **Diamond Barnett Fellowship** level, further honoring Barnett's enduring legacy of service and dedication.
