



Distinguished Club Criteria 2021-2022

Club must be at or above charter strength (15 members) and in good standing to be eligible.

Complete all the following:

- 1) The Club President and Secretary attend Club Leadership Education
- 2) Submit Club Election Results and all Monthly Reports.
- 3) Provide all Club members with information on the Youth Protection Guidelines and report it on the Secretary Dashboard.
- 4) The club has a Membership Chair, and it is reported on the Secretary's Dashboard.

Complete at least 5 of the following:

- 1) A club member participates in the Kiwanis Amplify leadership development program.
- 2) The club completes a Community Needs Survey.
- 3) Perform a Club Member Satisfaction Survey **OR** Request assistance from a Club Coach.
- 4) At least one Club member attends Mid-Year Education Day **AND** send at least one delegate to District Convention and International Convention (NOTE: It does not have to be the same person attending each event)
- 5) Sponsor or help open a new Kiwanis club **OR** Sponsor or help open a new Service Leadership Program Club (K-Kids, Builders Club, Key Club, Circle K, or Aktion Club) **OR** reopen / reactivate a Service Leadership Program Club (K-Kids, Builders Club, Key Club, Circle K, or Aktion Club) closed or inactive due to COVID-19
- 6) Increase club membership by 10% or add five (5) new members (whichever is greater for the club)
- 7) Provide a sponsorship for the Aktion Club Convention, Circle K International District Convention or Key Club District Leadership Conference **OR** Provide scholarships for at least one student to attend the Aktion Club Convention, Circle K International District Convention, Key Club District Leadership Conference, or Key Leader
- 8) \$10.00 per member donation to the Kiwanis Children's Fund, or a 5% increase over the previous year; **OR** a \$5.00 per member donation to the Ohio District Kiwanis Foundation (**Bonus point if the Club does both**)
- 9) Host a presentation by the County Emergency Management Agency or Red Cross on disaster relief and recovery and how a Club can be involved / provide support.

Distinguished Division Criteria 2021-2022

- 1) All clubs are in good standing and 75% are at or above charter strength (15 members)
- 2) The Division's Lt. Governor-elect is elected and reported to the District Office by May 15
- 3) 75% of Clubs in the Division have Club Presidents and Secretaries attend Club Leadership Education training
- 4) 25% of clubs complete a Community Needs Survey
- 5) Open or help open a new Kiwanis club **OR** a new Service Leadership Program Club (K-Kids, Builders Club, Key Club, Circle K, or Aktion Club) **OR** 50% of clubs in the division increase club membership 10% or add five (5) new members (whichever is greater for that club)
- 6) 25% of Clubs provide a sponsorship for the Aktion Club Convention, Circle K International District Convention, or Key Club District Leadership Conference **OR** provide at least one scholarship to attend Aktion Club Convention, Circle K International District Convention, Key Club District Leadership Conference, or Key Leader
- 7) At least one club in the division publicizes its Signature Project in the Buckeye Bulletin **OR** submits its Signature Project for the Signature Project competition.
- 8) Schedule and hold a presentation by the Chair of the First Family's Project before January 31, 2021
