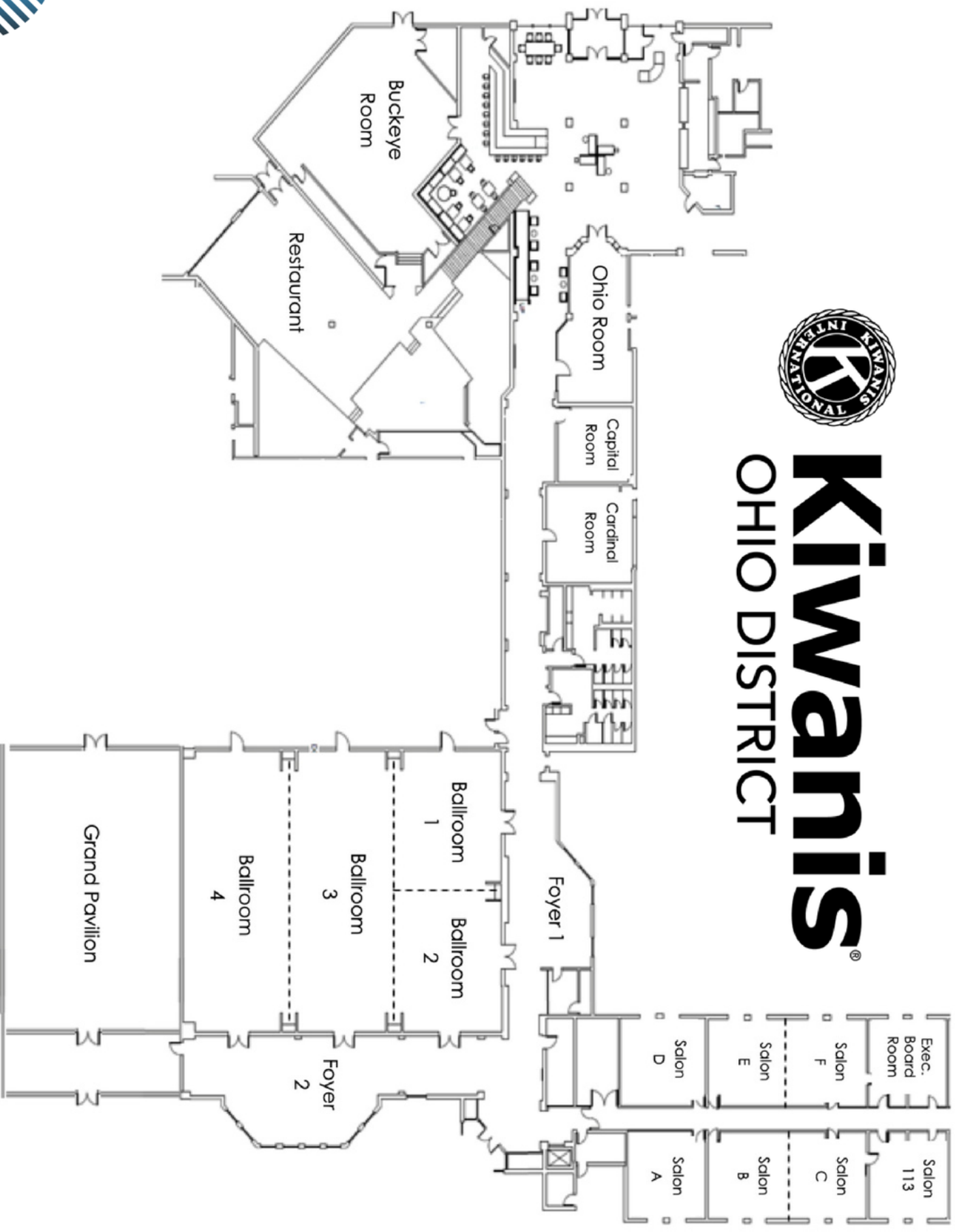

During the 2021-22 Kiwanis year only one third of the Kiwanis clubs in the Ohio District reported their service hours and fundraising activities.

The members of those clubs donated 51,282 hours – over 2,100 days - of service toward dozens of projects to benefit their neighbors and communities. These clubs returned \$844,815 – over \$12,000 per club - back into their communities.

All told, the value of the service* and financial support provided to about 70 communities in 2021-22 was \$2,378,710.90.
