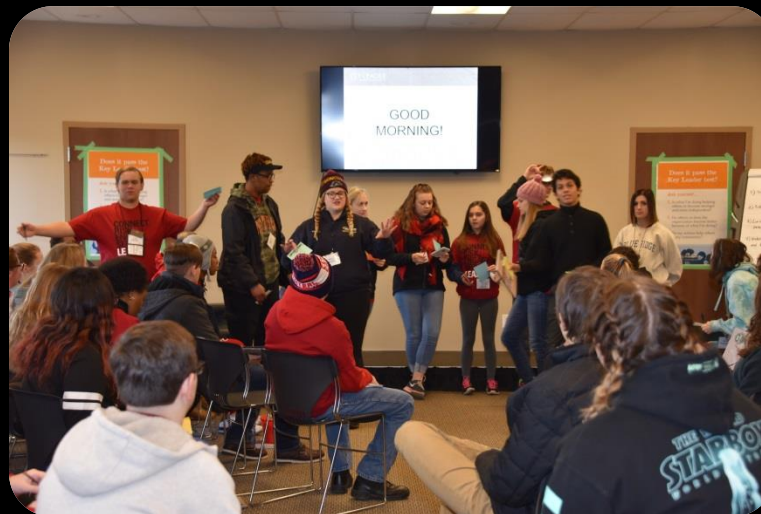

 - Small and large group discussion and activities
 - Low ropes/team building
 - Saturday night social

 - Site Coordinator (Brian Yacucci)
 - Other volunteers as needed by committee





- What students are eligible to attend?
 - 9th-12th grade students
 - No limit on the number of students from any one school or group
 - No academic, athletic or other requirements
 - ALL are welcome!





- Where do the students come from?
 - All over Ohio
 - Your family, friends, neighbors
 - Your local high school
 - Key Club and other student groups
 - Church groups
 - Community groups
 - Scouts, YMCA, FFA, etc.
 - Boys and Girls Clubs





- What is included in the registration fee?
 - EVERYTHING!
 - Two nights lodging (cabins)
 - Five meals and snacks
 - Low ropes course
 - Lead facilitator selected and trained by KI
 - Various take home items
 - Curriculum workbook and other giveaways
