SAHMRI 'ALL' Program Childhood Cancer Research – into Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia

Why are we collecting funds?

SAHMRI (South Australian Health and Medical Research Institute) unite with researchers and families in the fight against Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia ('ALL') with Childhood Cancer Research.

The partnership helps to better inform current research practices and support services available for cancer patients.

What is Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia ('ALL' program)?

- 'ALL' is a cancer that affects the blood and bone marrow
- Treatments include intense chemotherapy, radiation therapy, transplantation and irradiation
- More than 400 people are diagnosed with 'ALL' each year in Australia and this is increasing with ~80% being children
- 'ALL' remains the leading cause of non-traumatic death in children in the western world
- Survivors are 5 times more likely to develop a second cancer
