I found this old photo from 2015 of members and friends assembling cards and flowers. We have been delivering cards for over 35 years!

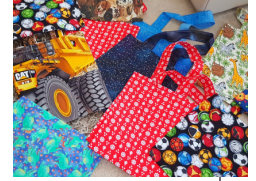

Projects completed in April, 2026:

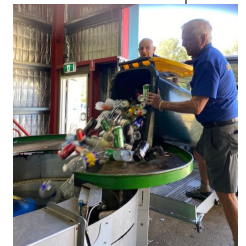
