Future project plan- ning: As we all know, projects do not happen without planning. While not completing any one project, members have engaged in planning for the next **few months projects.**



The first president of Kiwanis International was George F. Hixson of the Rochester, New York, Kiwanis Club. He was elected in 1916 at the first international convention in Cleveland and re-elected the next year. He is the only international president to serve two terms.
