## **PROGRAMS YOU MAY HAVE MISSED**

Gleaves Whitney spoke about President Gerald R Ford and his legacy. The strongest trait and attribute of President Ford was his virtuous life. He was one of few presidents that did not have any scandals associated with his time in office. In 2001 Ford received the John F. Kennedy "Profile In Courage" award for taking a political risk of pardoning former President Richard Nixon after Watergate. Many believe that pardon cost Ford the 1976 presidential election. The award is given annually to an elected official who followed his conscience despite the political cost.

Sarah Reid and Tim Lopez from Kids' Food Basket gave us an update on childhood hunger. Kids' Food basket provides approximately 9,000 sack suppers to students across West Michigan. They have three locations for food packaging in Grand Rapids, Muskegon and Holland. They receive very little in federal funding and private donors and corporations make up the majority of their funding. They have a farm where they grow food and teach children about where food comes from.





Gregg Dimkoff is a professor at the GVSU Seidman College of Business and spoke to the club about Avoiding Financial Scams. Seniors are one of the top targets for scams. They typically have money, are trusting, and may have reduced mental capacity. He discussed the most common types of scams including the FBI's 10 top 10 scams. Even some of the smartest people can become victims of financial scams.
