

2025 Kiwanis Service Scholarship Overview and Criteria

Kiwanis is a global organization of volunteers focused on improving the lives of children, one child and one community at a time. The Kiwanis Club of the Main Line is delighted to offer two (2) \$2,500 academic scholarships during the 2024 academic year to students who demonstrate servant leadership in their school and community that align with the Kiwanis's commitment to community service.

Scholarship Value: \$2500 each for two (2) students at participating high schools

Scholarships will be awarded to students who have demonstrated **leadership in service or volunteering**. All applicants must meet the scholarship criteria and complete all application requirements to be considered for a 2025 Kiwanis Service Scholarship.

Examples of servant leadership, (but not limited to) include:

- the applicant has established a multi-year commitment to a volunteer activity;
- the applicant has launched and maintained a service project of significance; or
- through their efforts and time commitment, the applicant has inspired and led a significant outcome (such as funds raised, food or clothing collected for donation, etc.).

Scholarship Criteria

- 1. **Must be a student at a participating school**: Harriton, Lower Merion, Haverford, or Radnor High Schools, or a private high school within the Main Line.
- 2. **Grade Level:** Senior at a participating school.
- 3. Completed at least 100 hours of community service or volunteering hours between January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.
- 4. Academic Grade Minimum: B average

Application Requirements

- Submit One Page Essay: submit an essay describing your volunteering and/or servant leadership experience(s)
 that has made the most impact on you and your school/community. Describe the service provided, how it impacted
 your school or community, why it is meaningful to you, and how you have inspired others. The essay length is
 approximately one page in length typed.
- 2. **Letter of Recommendation:** obtain at least ONE (1) letter of recommendation(s) from individual(s) verifying your activities and community service.
- 3. Ensure Academic GPA is verified by school official through signature. Note: Electronic Signature is acceptable

Application Submission Instructions

- 1. Please complete the **Kiwanis of the Main Line Service Scholarship Application Form** and follow the instructions for submitting all <u>required application materials</u>.

- 3. Deadline to Submit Application and Materials: March 31, 2025

Judging and Awarding Process: A panel of Kiwanis judges will evaluate the scholarship applications and recipients will be informed of the status of their application by <u>May 1, 2025</u>. Scholarships will be issued directly to the winner's educational institution.
