Mary fixed the dual Facebook pages so the Facebook page is now current, and Katie is working on getting our new web site up and running! Lee reminded us that there are two weeks left for completion of our scholarship applications. We have not yet received any applications, but Chad is looking into that situation.

Our honorary guest today was CPT Dan Rosenthal. He has been with the Mehlville Fire District for 22 years. Prior to Mehlville, he started with the Ferguson Fire Department at the age of 19, and then worked with Ferguson Police Department as well. Currently he runs the Mehlville fire house Number 1. He plans on retiring on July 1, after 41 years of service. CPT Dan's fire house responded to between 2300 and 2400 calls last year, making it one of the busiest fire houses in the county. 53% of all calls are for EMS. The Mehlville Fire District has twice the recovery rate state-wide for cardiac cases. Due to the increases in EMS cases, additional employees, and other costs, the district is asking for a tax raise on the April 5 ballot. Currently,
