donated to the mission. There are 10 members in the ministry. They started a church with a hand full of widows that has since grown to over 400 members. Ten more churches are now in place. The ministry also has supplied sewing machines and crop production training to further self-sufficiency. Sam stated that the ministry will continue to support this region since they are in the most need. Their difficulties stem from flooding, but mostly from civil war and unrest.
